

Privileges and Responsibilities of DIAA Membership;

1. All members who have joined in the calendar year are eligible to show in an **All-Member Show** if they submit their work and information for advertising and labels by the deadlines announced by the Exhibition Committee (rules and dates can change somewhat from year to year). There is a hanging fee, usually \$15.00. The DIAA takes a 35% commission on all works sold at this and all exhibits.
2. All members are eligible to show multiple pieces of their work in one of the **prime-time summer shows (referred to as "Theme Shows")**, if they are paid members and submit information to the Exhibition Committee by the March 1 deadline. There is a hanging fee (usually \$35) to participate in these shows which helps to cover advertising costs. Prior year members will receive a mailing containing renewal membership and theme show information in January. **New members must send in membership application forms before February 1 to participate in that year's Theme Shows. This provides enough time to add them to the membership list and email them the information.**
3. All members may participate in the **end of season shows**, usually beginning in early to mid-September. There is a hanging fee (usually \$35) to help cover advertising costs. They must meet the deadlines for submitting information for labels and delivering (and picking up) work.
4. In addition, there is usually a **November/December show of Small Works**. The hanging fee is often lower than \$35 and this exhibit may be opened to invited guest artists.
5. Members may also put their unframed work in the bin in the gallery providing it meets size and labeling criteria. Limit four pieces per person.
6. All Members may submit an image and brief description of their work for the **DIAA website** at no charge.
7. All Artist members are expected to volunteer their services to the DIAA by gallery sitting, providing refreshments, helping to hang shows, suggesting and helping to organize speaker workshop programs and assisting the DIAA in daily operations. Patron members are invited to participate in all of the above activities. Their support is greatly appreciated.
